VOLUNTEER BENEFITS

VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

- Must be at least 19 years of age to volunteer
- Comfortable interacting with the public
- A great attitude!!

TYPES OF VOLUNTEER WORK

SET UP

This team is dedicated to helping the site managers getting things ready at the venue. These volunteers move, prep, generally doing what is needed to make the venue ready. This role may include some heavy lifting. (4 per shift)

- 2pm to 6pm

Saturday, April 1

- 9am to 1pm

PREP TEAM

These volunteers will work together to prepare glassware & sample tickets for distribution. (6 per shift)

Friday, March 31

- 1pm to 5pm

VIP AND MAIN GATES – greeters

These volunteers will work as a team to put on wristbands, pass out glassware & sample tickets, answer questions, and help guide attendees into the event. After the rush, most will be reassigned to help out the other positions including selling additional sample tickets and merchandise. (6 per shift)

BOX OFFICE

These volunteers will sell tickets to the festival at the door for folks who didn't purchase their tickets before the event. Training on the Ticket Halifax site will be provided. (4 per shift)

MERCHANDISE

These volunteers will sell *Together We Brew* branded merchandise and extra sample tickets (2 per shift)

POURERS

Our pourers may assist the breweries during each of the tasting sessions. You will either assist with a specific brewery or pouring at our *Together We Brew* Bar; beers from breweries who were unable to attend in person. Our pourers will be under the guidance of a representative from the brewing industry. (6 per shift)

BREWERY SUPPORT TEAM

Your job is to help brewers keep the beer flowing! Distributing ice, additional supplies, filling/emptying rinse water, cleaning away dumped beer and recyclables. (6 per shift)

SITE SUPPORT TEAM (FOR EACH SESSION)

These volunteers are responsible for keeping the venue clean which include duties such as waste management, broken glass cleanup, collecting sample ticket bags from brewers. (6 per shift)

LOAD OUT

This team is dedicated to helping the site managers return the venue to its original format. These volunteers move equipment, pack up items: generally doing what is needed. This role may include some heavy lifting. (4 per shift)
